A REMINDER OF WHO WE ARE



We are a small NPO PBO run by volunteers.

We have three main roles within the community of the Valley of 1000 Hills which are;

Tertiary Fund : we make up the shortfall in the National Student Financial Aid Scheme through paying fee shortfalls, books, transport, equipment also through coaching, mentoring, providing advice and support, CV advice and interview practice. Over 95% of our students complete their tertiary qualification (compared with around 50% nationally) and enter into sustainable career so breaking the cycle of poverty and becoming economic and social contributors to our community.

Schools Fund : providing uniforms to the most impoverished children at quintile schools. Also paying the Central Applications Office (CAO) application fee for bright but financially impoverished matric learners recommended for help by their Head of Year.

Advice Bureau : providing paralegal advice and support enabling community members to access their rightful grants and pensions as well as road traffic fund payments, birth certificates and ID's. Food parcels are issued to needy families for a few months as necessary
